

Setting up Restrictions on Your iPad

SETTING UP RESTRICTIONS

Restrictions can be applied on the iPad to restrict a person's access to certain content including:

- iTunes store
- Web browser
- Facetime
- Installing and deleting apps
- In app purchases
- 18+ content

1. To set up restriction first enter the 'Settings menu' by tapping the



2. Scroll down the menu and press on 'General'. Scroll down the menu and press on 'Restrictions'.



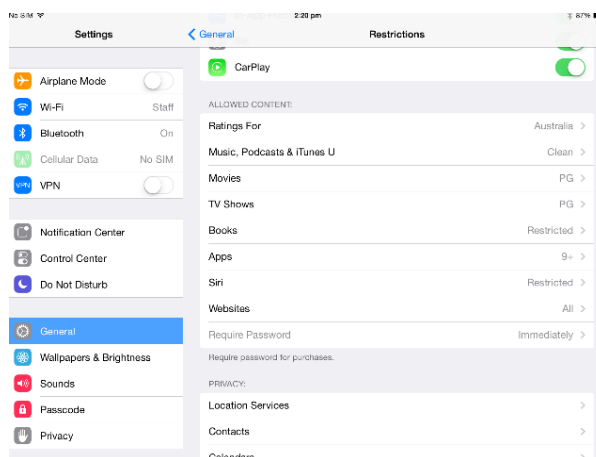
3. Click on 'enable restrictions'. The device will ask you to set up a passcode that needs to be entered before accessing the restrictions menu. This 'locks' the menu only people with the passcode can change the restrictions.



1. Hide apps that the person may not need to access like Facetime, in app purchases and Safari. Do this by tapping on the on/off toggle on the right hand side.

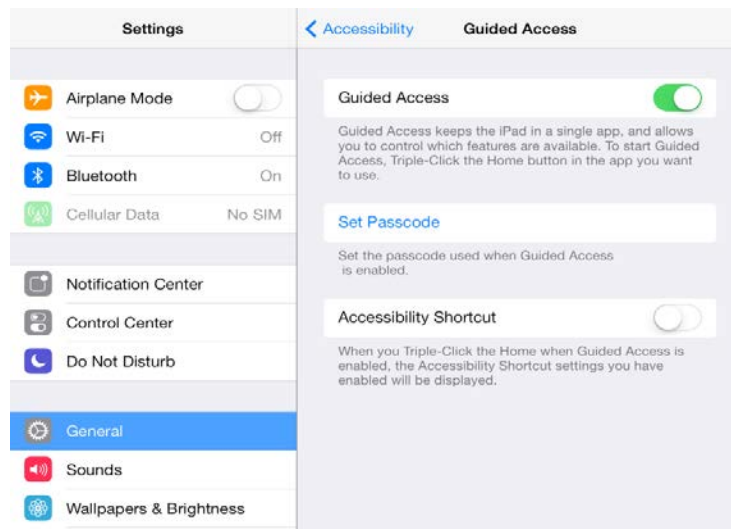


2. Restrictions can also be applied to the rating of content on the device. This can be particularly useful if explicit content must be restricted for example when a person is browsing the web or downloading music. Use the 'content allowed for' menu to change this.
3. Click on 'ratings for' and select 'Australia'. Click on the categories music, movies, TV show etc. and choose the rating level for the individual using the device.

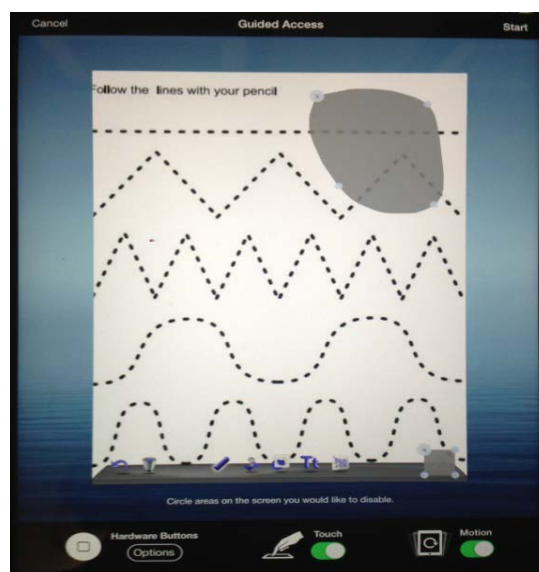


SETTING UP GUIDED ACCESS

1. This feature allows you to temporarily restrict the iPad to a particular app by disabling specific areas of the screen and preventing the person from exiting the app.
2. To set up this feature, click on Setting > General > Accessibility > Guided Access. Make sure you turn Guided Access on and set a passcode.



4. Return to the home page and select the app for the person to use.
5. Once the app has opened, triple-click the Home button.
6. This will then allow you to select buttons and areas of the screen to disable.
7. Circle any part of the screen that you would like to prevent the person from using such as menus areas.
8. Once you have chosen the area, click "start." This will turn on guided access.



9. To end the Guided Access session, triple-click the Home button and enter the password, then select "end."
